The policy of this company is:


- To comply with national and EU legislation as a minimum requirement.

- To plan for emergencies
- To provide facilities for the welfare of all our employees.
- To provide a work environment that strives to prevent unsafe work practices.

To this end it is anticipated that all employees will co-operate with all company initiatives and take reasonable care to ensure the safety, health and welfare of both themselves and their fellow workers.

They shall furthermore report to their immediate supervisor any defects to plant, equipment or systems or work which might endanger the health, safety and welfare of company employees.

Protech Performance Plastics operates a health and safety management system structured in accordance with the requirements of OHSAS 18001. The system will be used to ensure that health and safety management is given the attention and resources that it deserves.
